# Heathcote Liquid Amber Trail

106 High Street, Heathcote**

This trail includes sealed and unsealed paths and may not be suitable for wheelchairs and mobility walkers. Be aware of traffic, there are two road crossings on this trail.

The rules are simple:

- Head to the start point and start your walk.
- Mark off the sites on the Bingo card as you see them.
- Once you find all the sites in a straight vertical, horizontal or diagonal line you've got Bingo!
